Labor Requirements: There is a minimum labor charge, of 1 1/2 hours for install and dismantle. CES dosn't control the Events Schedule, therefore can't control if set-up/disconnect is during straight time or overtime hours. Laying of any lines under carpet or other flooring, or spoting from ceiling will be from ceiling will be an additional Labor and Material Charge. Additional Connections: If you have more than one machine or multiple connections on a machine order an additional connection for each machine or connection within 20 ft. of the outlet ordered. Otherwise you must order another outlet.

Outlet Distribution: Outlets are delivered to the rear of inline and peninsula booths and to one location in island booths. Ramping or laying of lines on floor in booth or spotting from the ceiling will be done on a time and material basis Lift charges will apply for overhead drops or distribution.

Service Connections: All service connections are to be made by Convention Electric Plumbers. Material charges may apply.

Air Line Responsibilities: Convention Electric Inc. is not responsible for moisture, oil or water in air lines, or loss of flow or drop or increase in pressure in line to equipment. Exhibitor

should supply their own filters, driers or other equipment as needed. No compressors are allowed other than those supplied by Convention Electric, Inc. unless they are a fixed part of your machine. Dedicated and 24 Hour service will be at 50% more the listed price.

<u>Water Pressure</u>: Pressure may vary. No guarantee can be made to minimum or maximum pressures. If pressure is critical the exhibitor should arrange to have a pressure regulator valve or pump installed. Convention Electric Inc. is not responsible for sediment, color or taste of water.

- 1 Payment must be included with your order to secure the Advance Rate. Please see the Plumbing order form for the advance rate deadline date. Orders received without payment will not be guarantee Advance Rates. Orders received less than 21 days prior to scheduled event opening will be charged the regular rate. A photocopy of the check will not be accepted to receive the Advance Rate. In the event that totals are calculated incorrectly, Convention Electric Inc. reserves the right to make the necessary corrections.
- 2 All material and equipment furnished by Convention Electric, Inc. for this service order shall remain CES property and shall be removed ONLY by Convention Electric, Inc at the close of the show.

3 Wall, column and permanent building utility outlets are not part of booth space and are not to be used by exhibitors.

- 4 All equipment must comply with state and local codes.
- 5 Claims will not be considered or adjustments made unless filed by the Exhibitor in writing prior to close of the event, no exceptions.
- 6 Prices based upon current wage rates and are subject to change without notice.
- 7 Under no circumstances shall anyone other than Convention Electric, Inc. Plumbing personnel make service connections.
- 8 Special equipment requiring company engineering or technicians for assembly. Servicing, preparatory work and operation may be executed without Convention Electric, Inc. Plumbing personal. However, all connections to such equipment must be made by Convention Electric, Inc. Plumbing personal ONLY.
- 9 All equipment using water must have inlet and outlet properly tagged.
- 10 Unless otherwise directed, Convention Electric Inc. personnel are authorized to cut floor coverings to permit installing service(s) ordered.
- 11 Connection rates listed cover bringing service from main line to booth and do not include connecting equipment.
- 12 Service outlet size is determined by the volume required. Air line size is dictated by the CFM requirements. Standard air lines terminate with a 1/2" female iron pipe valve.

13 All work performed within booth attahing lines to equipment will be charged on a time and material basis in addition to connection fees.

- 14 A separate connection fee will be made for each piece of equipment using connected service, wheather connected directly or otherwise.
- 15 Convention Electric Inc. must have 30 days notice in order to supply special regulators, strainers, traps, etc.
- 16 All Utility outlest include up to 50 feet of accomplished distance. Use of additional footage or equipment will be charged at the prevailing labor and material rates.
- 17 All Outlets will be installed on the floor at the vackwall of the booth.
- 18 Convention Electric Inc. will not be responsible for any sediment, color or taste of water in water line.
- 19 All services will be disconnected / shut off at conclusion of show unless advance notice has been given and acknowleged.
- 20 The CFM requirements (Cubic Feet per Minute) determine the volume of air required to properly operate exhibitor's equipment. CFM is a labor charge for sizing and installation of the installation of the service infrastructure.
- 21 In some instances a pump is required to drain services out of an exhibitor's booth. When this occurs, time & material charges apply. Exhibitors are encouraged to contact Convention, Electric Inc. to discuss any potential additional costs.
- 22 Compressed Air is supplied during show hours only. If compressed air is Dedicated and 24 Hour service will be at 50% more the listed price.
- 23 Pressure for Water Services may vary. No guarantee can be made of minimum or maximum pressure. If pressure is critical, the exhibitor should arrange to have a pressure regulator valve installed.
- 24 Natural Gas "when available" is not regulated by Convention Electric Inc. and is at the facility pressure (4oz.). Call for price quote when available.
- 25 Gas & Cylinders: When available 1025 1030 BTU per cubic foot at 7' water column pressure. Credit will not be provided on unused cylinders
- 26 Convention Electric Inc. will not be responsible for moisture or water in air lines. Exhibitors should supply their own filter or other equipment to handle moisture or water. For gas cylinders or any other special requirements call Convention Electric Inc. for a quote at (909) 623-5192. Delivery charges will apply to any specialty equipment delivered and removed from the exhibitor booths.
- 27 Credit will not be given for outlets installed or connections made and not used.
- 28 Payment in full for all plumbing services provided must be made in full prior to close of the event. If we have to bill you after event a 30% surcharge will apply of total bill.
